




GDP per capita Growth Rates






The increase in uses: The total increase and the contribution of uses 2004-2017






Israel's Goods and Services Exports and World Trade, 1995-2017

Labor Market, Quarterly, 1995-2017, 25-64







2006-2018











Factors in Israel that encourage innovation

- ✓ Quality universities that provide the economy with **human capital**, scientific aptitude, and technological abilities
- ✓ **Collaboration** between the **universities and industry**
- ✓ Government support for commercial R&D
- ✓ Developed **venture capital** industry



“Necessity is the mother of invention” – example

- **World leader in desalination;** With a network of five coastal desalination plants, which together produce **75%** of all water supply to households.
- Leading in **Waste-Water Recycling** with a rate of **80%**.
- Israel developed and patented the “**Drip Irrigation**”, that has not only produced huge reduction in agricultural water use, but has also vastly increased yields, and it is used worldwide.








Capital per worker in the business sector

Aged 15+, 2015






Inequality is Decreasing But it is Still Relatively High




Women in the Labor Market

1980-2016






Employment Rate by Population Groups



Israel Women Employment Rate, 25-64






The wage gap has declined, but still substantial: part of it stems from part time jobs that is common among women




The Big Dilemma: Work and Housework

minutes a day spent on daily activities-men and women






The Percentage of Women among B.A students in selected fields



Percentage of Women as Board Members of Largest Companies is Still Low in Most OECD Countries


% of Women on Board of Largest Companies,





Gender Distribution among employees of the Bank if Israel


