

Call to find candidates for the position of Director of the Payment and Settlement Systems Department

The Governor of the Bank of Israel has appointed a search committee to identify candidates for the position of Director of the Payment and Settlement Systems Department.

Description of the position:

The Director of the Payment and Settlement Systems Department is responsible for supervision and regulation of the payment systems and operation of the ZAHAV system and the Paper-Based (Checks) Clearinghouse. The Director is a member of the Bank of Israel's management, and reports to the Deputy Governor.

Benchmark requirements:

- 1. At least five (5) years of experience in the fields of banking, finance, or another relevant field;
- 2. Recognized Bachelor's degree.

Qualifications:

- 1. Proven high-level management capabilities;
- 2. Experience in leading innovative projects;
- 3. Good knowledge of financial systems, technological innovation, and means of payment;
- 4. High-level oral and written communication ability, in Hebrew and English;
- 5. Advantage: Master's degree in economics and/or business administration or another relevant field;
- 6. Advantage: Experience in the field of financial innovation;
- 7. Advantage: Experience in the field of financial regulation;
- 8. Advantage will be given to a candidate with experience in managing senior executives and teams.

- Employment will be by personal contract, for a period of five years.
